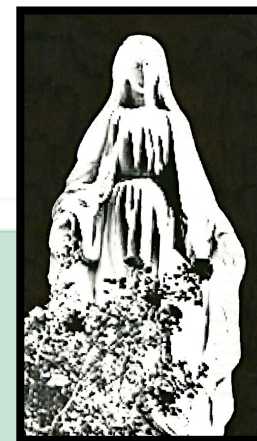

May 12, 1968

On this day 51 years ago, Our Lady of Light Parish celebrated the dedication of its new Church! According to parish history, the 14 plexiglass windows were installed, 11 of the 21 paintings (Stations, as they were called) were completed, as was the cry room. The celebration was combined with the sacrament of Confirmation. Later, it became the job of Fr. Richard Humphreys to finalize the remainder of this structure.
