

Dear Brothers and Sisters. Sometime ago I came across one of the sayings of the Greek philosopher Plato. It says, "Be kind, for everyone you meet is fighting a hard battle." This is true and it is the reality. Some have tougher battles and are more scarred than others. nonetheless each one of us has our own struggle. Some are just very good in covering up their pain and battle wounds pretending they are fine outside but inside their souls are groaning in pain. We need to understand and respect where people are coming from. Today, on this Second Sunday of Advent, the gospel narrative about John the Baptist preaching repentance and forgiveness reminds us of who we are as a people. We need to come back to the "wounded healer" our Lord. John spoke of him as someone who will baptize us with the Holy Spirit.
