

A Message from Father Rick

Unlike the gospels Matthew and Luke, who began their accounts with infancy narratives, Mark's gospel began with the ministry of Jesus. His accounts began with the preaching of John the Baptist, and then immediately followed by his short account of the baptism of Jesus at the River Jordan. Jesus' baptism defined the beginning of his public ministry. Just like everyone else Jesus received baptism of repentance by John though He had no sins to repent on. By Jesus' baptism he showed his solidarity with all of humanity that had been under the yoke of darkness of sin. By undergoing the same ritual, Jesus sanctified the waters which would later be used for all baptisms. Mark would end his gospel account with the words of Jesus commissioning His disciples. Jesus said to them, "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned." Let us pray that on this Feast of Jesus' baptism we may be reminded of our mission to bring others to the faith and be baptized.
