It is fitting that we celebrate on first Sunday of the year 2021, the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. This feast is traditionally symbolized by the visit of the three wise men or "kings" to the newly born child. Saint Matthew called them "Magi" from the east. Guided by a star they came to find Jesus and offered their gifts to the Messiah. 
