

A Message from Father Rick

Today we again witness another healing episode in the ministry of Jesus. Jesus healed a paralytic man who came to him begging, "If you wish, you can make me clean". Jesus maybe reluctant sometimes, but he never refused to heal the sick in his presence. Oftentimes, the healing stories were preceded by humility and faith on the person being healed. Lepers were outcasts during the time of Jesus not only because of their physical infirmities but also they were considered great sinners by the Pharisees. They were rejected and suppose to "quarantine" themselves indefinitely until they could show signs to the temple priests that they no longer had the leprosy. Jesus did more than just healing the person but restored the person to his family and to the community. Let us pray that we may have the grace to live our lives for others, for our family and for our community and not for ourselves alone.
