



My dear brothers and sisters, once again we are beginning the Lenten season in the liturgical calendar of the Church. The gospel this Sunday according to Mark succinctly summarizes the struggles that Jesus had to go through in order to realize and fulfill the proclamation of the Kingdom of God. The Spirit of Jesus fought against Satan's temptation in the desert, with the wild beasts and angels ministering him. There was a contrast between John being imprisoned and Jesus going out to proclaiming the gospel of God. Finally, the gospel gives us the core requirements for the fulfillment of God's kingdom which is repentance and believing in the gospel. We have a long way to go.
