

Mary Ann Webb (1936 - 2005)

A wife, mother, grandmother, and friend who lived in Descanso for 31 years. She exuded a generosity of spirit that drew others to her. As a teacher she had a dedication to education, not only to students in the Mountain Empire area, but also to those in San Diego County jails and at several Indian reservations throughout the county.

Mary Ann frequently furnished her time, energy, and love to many projects throughout the community. She became well-known at Descanso Town Hall functions for her peach and apple cobblers and at the Salvation Army where she showed great concern for the needs of others. She contributed her talents frequently to Catholic Charities, Rachel's House, and took great pleasure at being a storyteller for the children at the Descanso Library. No request was ever too great for her to give her best effort.

Mary Ann was devoted to her faith, especially to the Blessed Mother and the rosary, and to her parish community where for years she was the organist, and music and choir director. She was also the annual Deep Pit BBQ chairwoman and renowned for the best apple pies there.

Mary Ann's totally giving spirit, her willingness to devote time and energy putting her own needs aside for others, truly showed the heart of Jesus. Mary Ann was a great inspiration to all who knew her. The Mary Ann Webb Education Grant is indeed an appropriate gift to the children of Our Lady of Light Parish.
