

Do you find yourself murmuring or even complaining about life, about anything or even against God? Don't worry, you are not alone. The *Israelites, while they were in the* desert, complained against God. Prophet Elijah prayed for death. God never gave up on his people nor did He abandon Prophet Elijah. *On the contrary, God provided for* them with what was necessary. People murmured against Jesus' teachings. Jesus, however, stood his ground, saying; "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." Jesus used parables and allegories when teaching about the Kingdom of God; but not about his teaching of the true bread of life. Jesus is the bread of life. May the Lord continue to nourish and strengthen us with his Body and *Blood every time we celebrate* the Holy Eucharist.
