Last weekend, the Diocese of San Diego began the campaign for the Eucharistic renewal of the entire Diocese. For three consecutive Sundays there will be a particular theme around which all priests in the Diocese will be preaching about. Priests have the option of showing the pre-recorded homilies by different priests in video or in audio. Last Sunday's theme reminded us that the Eucharist is a direct and personal encounter with our Lord Jesus Christ, making the Eucharist as the source and summit of our Christian Life. This week, the theme for our reflection will be, the Eucharist as a sacrificial memorial of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection. This is what we call "the paschal mystery" through which we have been redeemed. When we celebrate the Holy Eucharist we do not simply remember the past events but also we make present the sacrifice of Christ on the cross, his death and his resurrection. Thus, every mass that we celebrate, we become active participants of Christ divine act of saving the whole of humanity.

The gospel this Sunday reminds us to live our "Eucharistic life" by striving to walk humbly, and to deal with others kindly and respectfully.
