A Message from Father Rick



The Gospel reading for this weekend's Masses is specially chosen for the third Eucharistic Theme which is "The Eucharist is the sacred meal that nurtures us, bonds us together and sends us forth to transform the world". The Gospel is the story of the two disciples on their way to a village called Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35). Though Jesus walked with them on the way, they did not recognize him. They were so defeated and saddened by events that their master was crucified and had died on the cross. When they sat with the stranger and saw him break the bread, they recognized him as their Master, Jesus who rose from the dead. After all, Jesus was alive. Through the breaking of the bread with Jesus, their hopes and dreams came alive and they came back to Jerusalem. This is our greatest hope too, that by participating in the Holy Eucharist, the breaking of the bread, we will be nurtured and transformed into becoming zealous and active members of the Body of Christ. Like the disciples, who came back to Jerusalem, a place of persecution and death, we too will have the grace and strength to face our daily trials and even persecution.

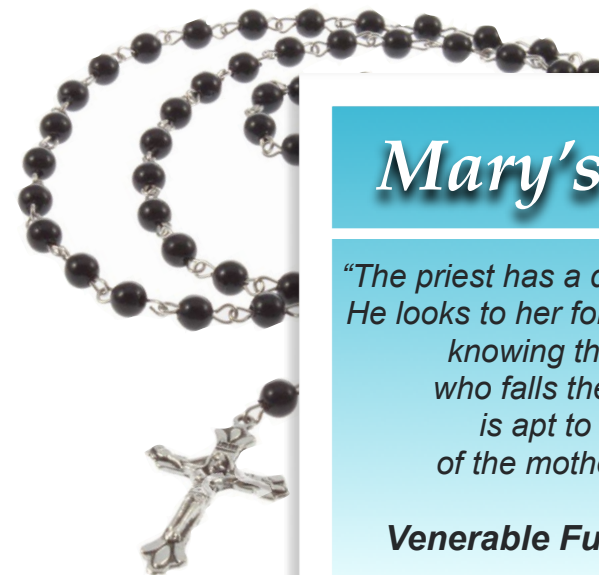


Lectors Needed
