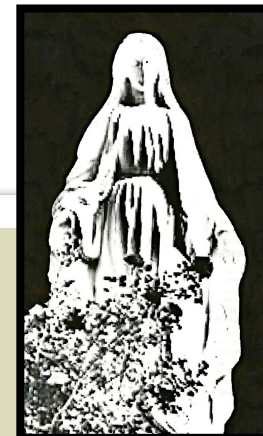

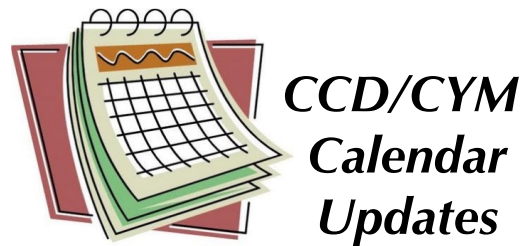

Parish Office Hours

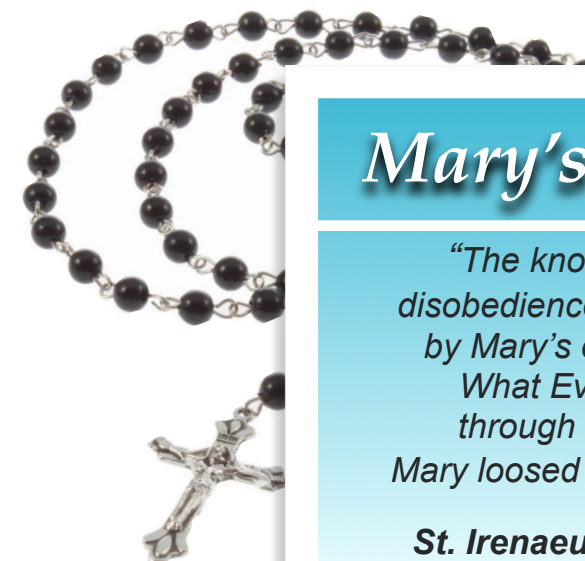
