A new liturgical calendar of the Church begins on this First Sunday of Advent. The theme of our Scripture readings is preparedness. We are reminded to prepare for two kinds of coming; first, the final coming of the *Cosmic Christ; and the second, the* personal coming of Christ into our individual hearts. In both cases Jesus reminds us to be watchful and alert, not to let our hearts be drowsy nor be overcome by the anxieties that daily life offers. After having gone through almost two years of the pandemic, we somehow, by the grace of God survive, but we are aware many did not and many more are still struggling and suffering.
