The Octave of Christmas

As Catholics we recognize that the Nativity of the Lord, is not just one day, December 25, but instead lasts eight days or octave of Christmas. For us the Octave begins on Christmas Day and goes until January 1, the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. In the liturgical calendar, each day in the octave is treated equally to the original feast day of the Nativity of our Lord. Our church's Octave is filled with various feast days, but each day is still another "little Christmas". The Church acknowledges that the days of the Christmas Octave are repeating the solemness of Christmas for eight days. and ends on a high note with another solemnity that is very similar to the Nativity of the Lord.
