# A Message from Father Rick

About three years ago, Rose, our neighbor in the Philippines, was diagnosed with cancer. From what I had heard the hospital already sent her home and the doctors refused to treat her. Her cancer was so advanced that it was considered hopeless. But she never gave up. She went from one hospital to another until she finally found one with a doctor who was willing to admit and treat her. I was able to talk to her and promised to prav for her healing. After a few months I called her again and was surprised. She was at home and in high spirits. She was recovering well. Praise God. On the second Sunday of Advent we hear the voice of John the Baptist crying out in the wilderness. He was a sign of protest and of hope as well. He embodied our longing for something better and different against the background of despair and hopelessness. The prophet shouted: "prepare the way of the Lord..." John the Baptist shows us a better way to live our lives, the way of hope and trust in God's promise. Let us choose the path of simplicity and humility. This is the path where the Lord, our messiah, will be born into our lives. While the world may tell us to give in and give up, the Word of the Lord is calling to faithfulness and perseverance. The Lord will never give up on us.


