What is Ordinary Time?

Ordinary Time represents the ordered life of the Church. A period in which we live our lives **neither** in feasting (as in the seasons of Christmas and Easter) or in penance (as in Advent and Lent), but waiting in expectation of the Second Coming of Christ.

The USCCB defines Ordinary Time as "a time for growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe."

So for Catholics, Ordinary Time is the part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives. Nothing "ordinary" about that!

Lectors Wanted and Needed

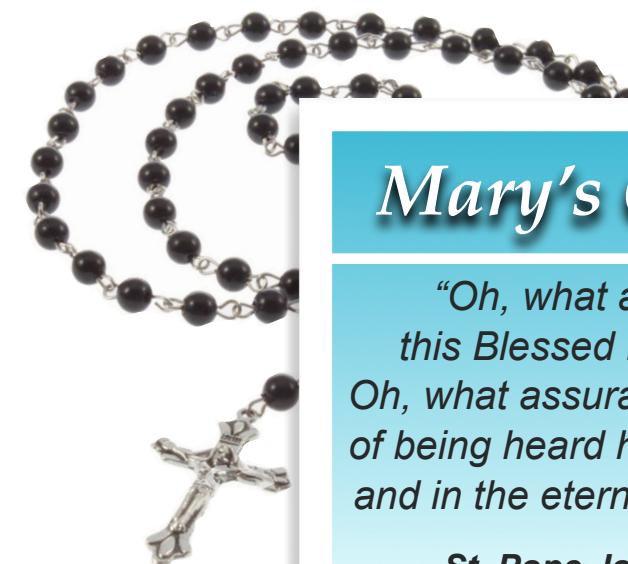
