We might be tempted to believe that our times are filled with more uncertainties compared to any period in history. This might be true, since unlike in the past where news was limited, today we can already have a sense of what is happening around the world. On a global scale, things are uncertain, and on a personal level uncertainties are real too. In the midst of all these, we are trying to make sense of our faith in God and in the words of the Holy Bible. Today's passage in the Gospel of St. Luke reminds us how the people of God continued to wait for the fulfillment of God's promise.
