What is Ordinary Time?

Ordinary Time represents the ordered life of the Church. A period in which we live our lives <u>neither</u> in feasting (as in the seasons of Christmas and Easter) or in penance (as in Advent and Lent), but waiting in expectation of the Second Coming of Christ.

The USCCB defines Ordinary Time as "a time for growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe."

So for Catholics, Ordinary Time is the part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives. Nothing "ordinary" about that!

Jesus' baptism by John marks the beginning of His public ministry which would last for about three years. Central to the ministry of Jesus was his act of calling disciples, and from the many disciples, he called twelve Apostles. This group of disciples would later constitute the early beginning of the church or "ecclesia." John the Baptist after having baptized Jesus would eventually disappear. He would be arrested and later would be beheaded by the Order of Herod. It is very important to note how Jesus received John's baptism of Him, a voice from the Heaven was heard, saying, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." The same voice would again be heard towards the end of Jesus ministry, when He and three other disciples would be on top of a mountain. During that moment, Jesus would momentarily and gloriously transfigure and a voice would be heard, "This is my beloved so in whom I am well pleased." The voice was for Jesus an assurance that He was not doing his own will but the Father's. From the beginning towards the end of his ministry Jesus would not be alone. The Father would always be there from the beginning to the very end. Let us be assured also that by virtue of our own baptism, the Father will also be with us alwavs.
