

# A Message from Father Rick

What is true happiness? And how can we ever achieve this most elusive reality of life? We must have heard that contentment is the secret of happiness? But how can there be contentment when not having enough causes so much pain and suffering. This must be what Jesus was trying to teach us in the Beatitudes.
