## 85th Annual BBQ

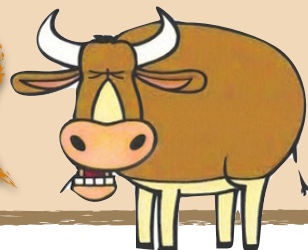
A big thank you to Barbara Telesmanic for stepping up to the plate to be this year's BBQ chairperson.
