Some people were asking for clarification on the Roe decision. This might help. The Court's decision in the Dobbs case that overturned the 1973 Roe v. Wade decision was a result of Justice Alito's key

finding: "The Constitution makes no reference to abortion, and no such right is implicitly protected by any constitutional provision," he writes. Wielding nothing but 'raw judicial power,' the Court usurped the power to address a question of profound moral and social importance that the Constitution unequivocally leaves for the
