Homeschool Co-op at Queen of Angels...

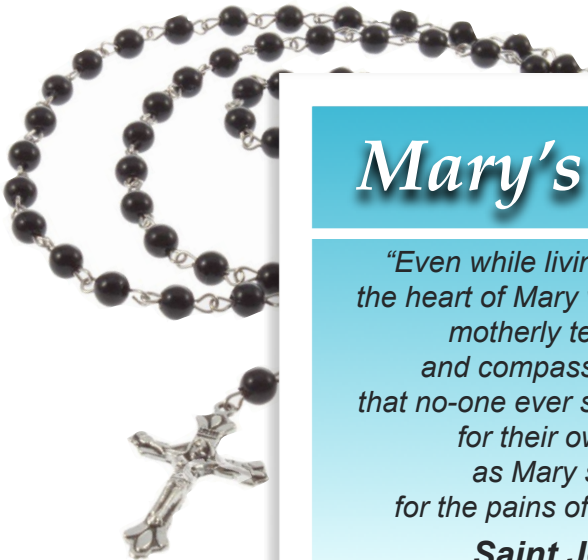
