

# A Message from Father Rick

We see God's love in action in Jesus. Since He began his public ministry, he never stayed in one place. He moved constantly from one place to another, even going to places that were non-Jews or gentles. Jewish people generally hated the gentiles even calling them "fuels for the fires of hell." Jesus challenged such attitude and ministered to the gentiles. To those who wanted to follow Him he gave a stern warning. "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children. brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple," he said. "Hate" is a strong word, but should not be interpreted as the abhorrent way that people dealt with their enemies or adversaries ordinarily. Jesus used the word "hate" to emphasize his radical demand of discipleship, that means family relationships should not hinder a disciple doing the Will of God. A disciple, for example, should be willing to leave his family in obedience to the call of God to be sent to a mission. Let us pray that more and more people will generously respond to God's call through a priestly or religious way of life.
