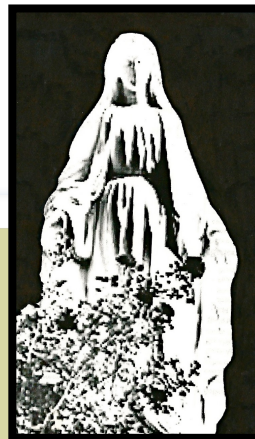

A Message from Father Rick

Zacchaeus, the chief tax collector climbed the sycamore tree in order to see Jesus. Not every day that Jesus would be passing by. Perhaps it was the first and only time. Zacchaeus saw it as an opportunity of a lifetime. He wanted to see Jesus even from a distance and that would be enough. He forgot about who he was, a rich man and a well-known tax collector. He became an object of shame and ridicule for what he did. The best thing about Jesus, He saw not a tax collector hated and despised by the Jews. Jesus saw a person, longing for peace and salvation. Saint Augustin in one of his sermons said, "Let Zacchaeus grasp the sycamore tree, and let the humble person climb the cross. That is little enough, merely to climb it. I rather think you make fun of the sycamore, and yet that is what has enabled me to see Jesus. You make fun of the sycamore, because you are just a person, but 'the foolishness of God is wiser than men.'" [Sermon 174.3] Are we willing to set aside pride and honor, climb a sycamore tree to see Jesus?
