



A Message Land From Father Rick

The Jewish people took great pride in their being the chosen people of God. In order to manifest their conviction of the divine election, they built a magnificent temple for the Lord. The temple became the center of Jewish religious activity. In today's gospel, Jesus prophesied that even this great temple would not last forever. Indeed, in 70AD, about 40 years after Jesus' death, the temple would be razed to the ground by the Romans. Material things do not last forever. Everything will come to an end. Jesus warned his disciples not to be concerned about the future impending catastrophic events, but rather to pray for God's intervention of grace and mercy. Jesus reminds us that there will be hostilities and persecutions. His disciples should respond with love, forbearance, and forgiveness. Only love and faithfulness can overcome prejudice, hatred, and envy. God's love purifies our hearts and minds of all that would divide and tear people apart. Knowing God as our compassionate Father and loving God's word of truth and righteousness are essential for overcoming evil. Jesus reminds us that we do not need to fear those who would oppose us or treat us harshly for following Him. He promises to give us supernatural strength, wisdom, and courage as we take a stand for our faith and winds to the truth and love of Christ.
