A Message from Father Rick

The liturgical calendar of the Church is ending in few Sundays from now. The tone of our liturgy this Sunday especially the biblical readings point to the end times. What will it be like in the afterlife? What will happen in the resurrection to come? The Sadducees, a group of sect in Judaism, did not believe in Resurrection. It is because resurrection is not explicitly written or revealed in the books of the Law of Moses. Jesus' answer to the Sadducees explains that life after the resurrection is different from the life on earth. Jesus gives three descriptions about the people of the resurrection. First, they are a people who can no longer die. Life in this world is subjected to death and decay. People of the resurrection live forever and ever. They are no longer subjected to time and change. Second, they are like angels. Angels are creatures of God. They have free will which means they can make judgment. An angel can decide to obey or disobey God. Generally, however, angels are depicted as happy and willing messengers of God. If I could be like an angel when I die, then I could also be happy and a willing messenger or servant of God. This is really something to hope for. Lastly, the people in the resurrection are the children of God. This means God and everyone in the resurrection belong to one family. In as much as God is a Trinity, then when we join God in the resurrection we become One Eternal Angelic/Human Family.
