The raising up of Lazarus happened towards the end of the ministry of Jesus. His impending betrayal, arrest, passion and death would be happening soon. The gospel does not tell us what kind of sickness Lazarus had suffered from. We know that any sickness that would lead to death is always painful not only to the sick but also to people who love him. When asked, why this event, namely the sickness, happened to his friend, Jesus' reply is noteworthy. He said, "That the Son of God maybe gloried through it." Lazarus' sickness and death for four days were meant so that in the end the glory and power of God would be revealed. Jesus, by the glory of the power of God, will raise Lazarus back to life. Jesus' own suffering and death would only be temporary. God in the end will show His mighty hand against suffering and death and will reveal that in the end there is resurrection. The resurrection too is our greatest hope. Yes, we still pray for the temporal healing or resolutions to our problems, but in the end, it is up to God to show His glory.
