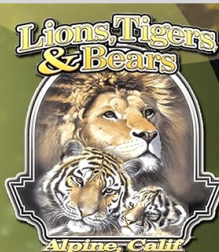

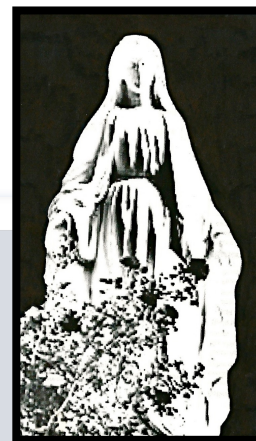

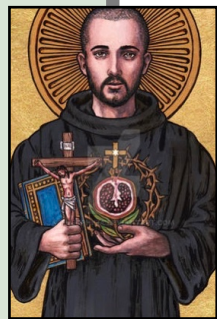

A Message from Father Rick



True love knows no bounds. True love is unconditional. And Jesus showed us that it is possible. He showed us the WAY so that following his example many would be willing to die like him so that others might live. St. Paul in his letter to the Romans beautifully summarizes the fate of those who willingly suffer for Christ and for others. "We are children of God. And if we are children we are heirs as well; heirs of God and coheirs with Christ, sharing his suffering so as to share his glory. I think that what we suffer in this life can never be compared to the glory, as yet unrevealed, which is waiting for us." (Rom. 8:17-18). We might be tempted to think that God's love for us is limited, conditional, and that he limits his love only to those who obey his commandments. God's unconditional love is always there. We have to make our choice to receive God's love and experience it through obedience. When we have gone through the process of painful obedience, then the fullness of God's true love will also be revealed in Glory. Jesus showed a glimpse of that Glory in this Sunday's gospel. In the presence of His three disciples Jesus was transformed into the Glory he would soon receive after his passion and death. The same heavenly glory awaits those who are willing to follow Jesus. The disciples were given hope. The same hope that we should carry on our journey as we struggle to carry our crosses.
