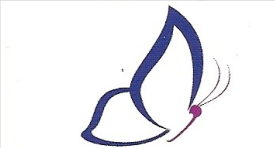

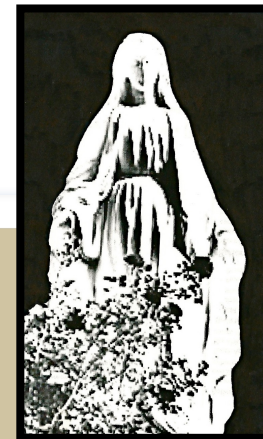

\*Raffle Tickets...keep selling raffle tickets to friends and family.

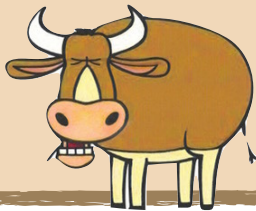

# A Message from Father Rick



Great gift, great responsibility. This is the phrase popularized by the Marvel movie Spiderman. Peter on this Sunday's gospel received not only the greatest compliments of his life but also something that made him the pillar of the Catholic Church. He received the "keys of the kingdom of heaven." What Peter received was pure Grace. Humanly speaking, Peter was not worthy and nothing he could do to make himself deserving of such wonderful gifts. His fellow disciples must have envied him so much. Many things in life and even including life itself are God's gifts. Some gifts we feel we deserve but many we do not. Some people may seem to receive more than others but the reality remains; there will always be corresponding responsibility to whatever people have received. Later, Peter would pay a very painful price for his words and for what he had received from the Lord. He was tortured and then crucified head down. What is important in our Christian life is to recognize the gifts of God and to be responsible for the use of such gifts. The greatness of Peter was his humility and readiness to call upon the Lord's help whenever he found himself drowning.
