

A Message Land

Jesus' teaching on forgiveness is probably the most difficult of all Christian teachings. Most of us probably want, if only it is possible, to be exempted from His commandment of loving even our enemies. It is because the enemies or our adversaries are the ones who are difficult to forgive. This might lead us to believe that perfection is indeed unattainable. When Jesus said, "be perfect as your Heavenly Father is perfect" He probably meant to "never stop trying to be perfect." Perfection after all is not a goal but a process. As long as we keep trying, we are on the right path. Jesus in this Sunday's parable makes an indispensable correlation between God's forgiveness and one's act of forgiving others in the same way that one cannot love God without loving one's neighbor. The parable also reminds us that forgiveness does not mean we should forget what had been owed or done. True forgiveness is a realization that God has forgiven us first and through the grace we have received we are able to forgive others from the heart. In other words, we have to realize that we are able to give because we have received so many blessings from God first.
