

A Message Land From Father Rick

God invites all to the holy banquet of the Holv Eucharist every Sunday. It is His Divine Will that people commemorate and celebrate the memorial of His son's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. By celebrating the Eucharist, we also bring about our unity and communion as One and Holy Body of Christ. The invitation for us to attend the holv sacrifice of the mass is like the king's invitation to his guests to attend his son's wedding banquet. In this Sunday's Gospel reading, Jesus compared the Kingdom of Heaven to a wedding banquet of the Son of the King. The king sent out invitation, but the invited quests insulted the king not only by ignoring his invitation but by even harming and killing the servants. Such evil acts of the invited quests would not go unpunished. The second part of the parable tells us that the king's invitation was sent out to everyone. God's offer of grace and salvation is now offered for all. Those who would accept God's invitation, however, must "dress up properly," meaning to say they must conform their lives to the will of God. Let us pray that as we respond to God's invitation and as He pours out His grace and blessings upon us we may conform our lives to his Divine Will.
