

A Message from Father Rick

Few days ago, I happened to hear an Eastern Orthodox preacher saying that the reason why there is no peace in Israel and in Palestine is that both the Jews and the Muslims had rejected Christ. I don't think that is entirely true. Acceptance of Jesus is never a quarantee for peace. In Luke 12:51 Jesus said, "Do you think I came to bring peace on earth? No, I tell you, but division." In today's Gospel, Jesus gives us possibly one of the pathways to true peace and that is obedience to the law of loving one's neighbor. Although there are many interpretations as to how we can love our neighbors, Jesus would teach us how. At the last the supper with his disciples Jesus gave a new commandment, "Love one another as I love you."
