Despite his physical limitations, his courage and tenacity for life caused him to become one of the biggest motivational speakers in the world. He has traveled to 78 countries and has written best-selling books. He is happily married and has two sons and two daughters. He is an example of a person who has received less but has given more. He did not bury the gifts he received but with courage and tenacity found his way not just to discover them but multiply them to more than a hundredfold. He had helped and touched thousands of people. In his helpless situation, he had truly supportive and loving parents who walked with him all the way. God wants us to realize how much each of us are blessed. May we become what God wants us to be. His beloved sons and daughters – fully human, fully alive.
