# A Message 💭 from Father Rick

There is more a lot to Christmas than what the world around tries to make us believe what it is. The liturgy for second Sunday of Advent tells what we are truly preparing for. Jesus reminds us to really prepare the way of his coming. John the Baptist is introduced to us as someone who prepared the way of the Lord. He did this by few words and tons of araphic images and actual witness; where he lived, how he dressed, what he ate, and what he longed to achieve. John said, "One mightier than I is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thonas of his sandals." John the Baptist lived his life with great humility. In this manner we too ought to cooperate in the plan of God. Like John the Baptist we strive to live humble and simple life. We must find time to be in the desert. not necessarily the actual desert, but a place where we can be alone with God and pray for a simple yet meaningful celebration of Christmas.
