The celebration of Holy Week begins with the triumphal entry of Jesus into His own city of Jerusalem and ends with His victory of sin and death. This year we are reading the Passion of Jesus according to St. Mark. One peculiar thing about St. Mark's account is that Jesus spent all his life at the service of others. St. Mark shows Jesus as the suffering servant who embraces the cross as a powerful manifestation of his self-giving. Those who are called to follow the Lord must also have that same spirit of self-giving. His disciples failed the test. They betrayed the Lord although in the beginning they said they could drink of the cup that Jesus would drink. They have not really understood the true demands of following the Lord. In a few days we will be walking with the Lord when we celebrate the Last Supper on Holy Thursday and when we pray the Stations of the Cross on Good Friday. May the Holy Spirit truly inspire and lead us to truly commit our lives to the Lord in the service and love of the Church and of our brothers and sisters. I pray that we will have all a Blessed Holy Week and a Glorious celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord.
