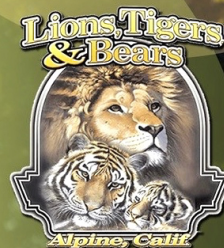

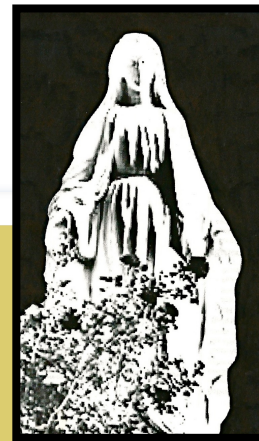

A Message from Father Rick



Four years ago 2018 on the occasion of the feast day of Saint Joseph, Pope Francis came out with a new apostolic exhortation entitled, "Gaudete et Exsultate." The Holy Father talked about what it means to be called holy in today's world. The first paragraph says, "REJOICE AND BE GLAD' (Mt 5:12), Jesus comforts those who are being persecuted or humiliated for the sake of the Gospel." The Lord asks everything from us, and in return He offers us true life, Eternal life. He wants us to be saints and not to settle for a bland and mediocre existence. Not everyone becomes holy in an instant. For many, holiness is a constant struggle to respond generously to God's call to love. It doesn't have to be a huge act of love like giving everything to charity. Jesus shows us in the parable of the mustard seed how big things happen with a very insignificant beginning. What is important according to Pope Francis is faithfulness and constant giving our very best for the Lord. There will be obstacles to holiness. A mustard seed cannot grow into a big shrub without going through the painful and difficult process of growth. God's call to holiness is always accompanied with His gift of Grace. He is truly a Father for us all.

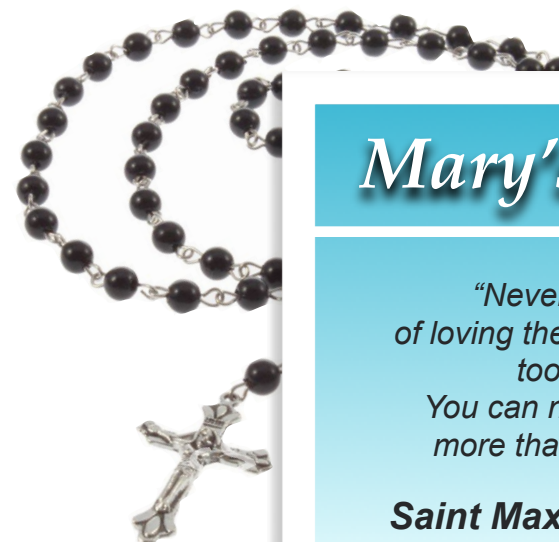
*Weed Whacking
