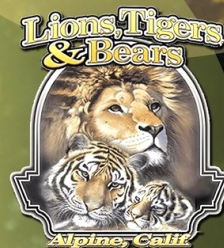

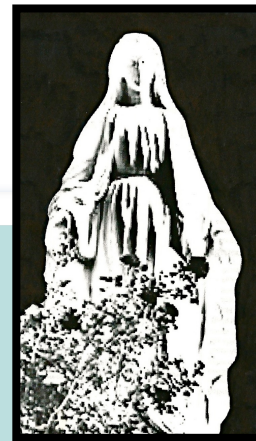

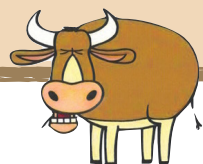

A Message from Father Rick



Birthdays are a great opportunity to remember and give thanks to God for everything. This coming Monday, June 24, will be the feast of the nativity of Saint John the Baptist. Although the celebration may not be as elaborate as Christmas, the birth of Jesus, we nonetheless celebrate John's birthday solemnity. Jesus in the Gospels spoke highly of John. Jesus said, "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John; yet the least in the kingdom of God is greater than he." (Luke 7:28). The name John means "the Lord is gracious". God cannot be outdone in Graciousness. Many times it is not easy to see God's blessings in our lives. We always see our inadequacies. We see imperfections and brokenness. The grace of God cannot at all times be seen on the surface. The celebration of John's nativity should remind us of God's Graciousness. John's miraculous birth shows God's extravagance by preparing his people for the coming of the Lord. God too gives us His Holy Spirit so that our faith will grow. God is always willing and ready to renew our faith, hope, and love. Let us pray that like John the Baptist, our lives become docile to the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

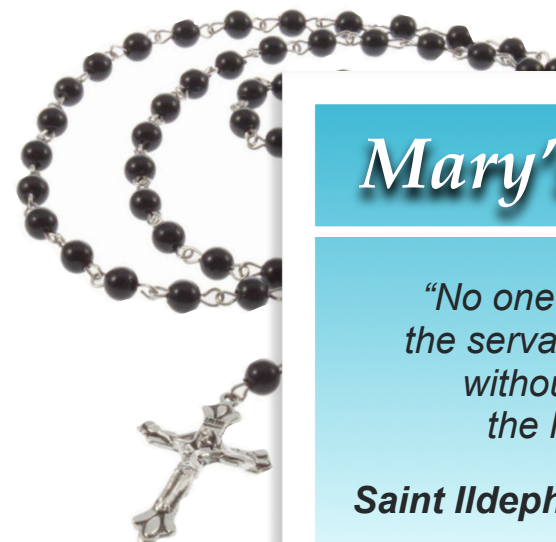
*Weed Whacking
