## A Message from Father Rick



At the last supper, Jesus said to his disciples, "I have told you this that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete." Joy should characterize our Christian life. We ought to be a joyful people. It is not always easy to be joyous. There are many sorrows in life. Jesus in our Gospels this Sunday is telling his disciples, "go into the world and see the sorrows of people and drive away the reasons of their sorrows like driving out their demons and curing their illnesses." Impossible! It is possible if the disciples themselves are free from the usual worries that beset people in everyday life, food, money, clothing, etc. One way to be happy is to be reminded of our calling, that we are called to imitate Christ. Saint Paul tells us that, "God chose us in Christ to be holy and blameless in his sight, to be full of love." We, therefore, need to set our sights on God and on our mission to others.
