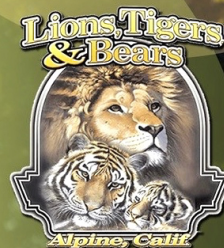

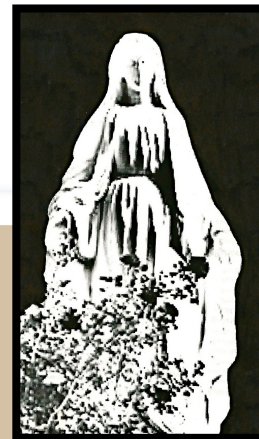

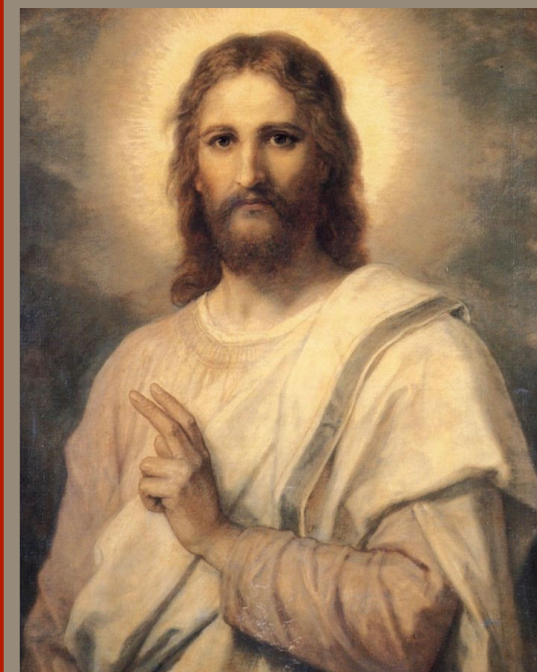

Desperately in need of people to work the PM Kitchen shift, Nachos, and soda/water booths.

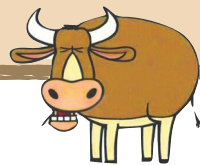
**\*Please Understand...** We have positions that **MUST** have complete coverage.
