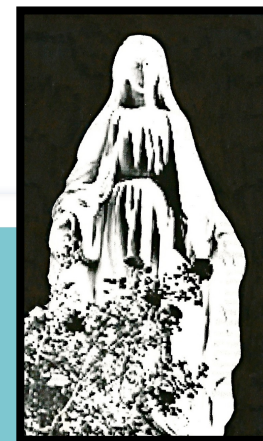

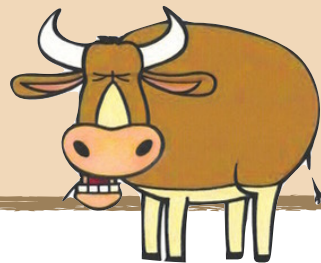

**\*Work Party Schedule...**

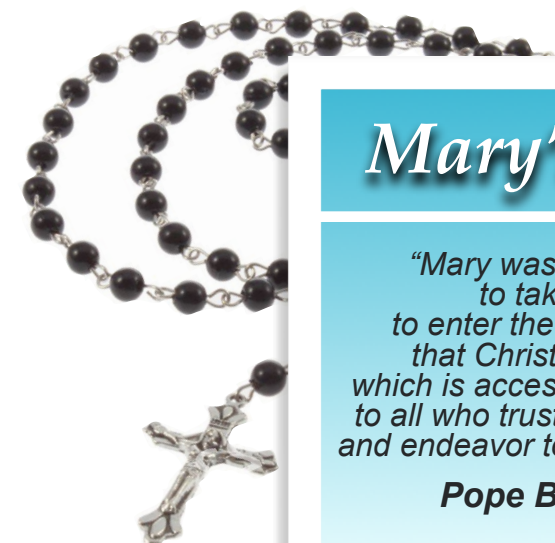
*We still need your help to tear down on Monday, September 2.* The more hands the faster it goes. Lunch provided on that day!
