With Father Rick away it is once again time for facts about the Catholic church... Did you know...

*The pope is protected by the Swiss Papal Guard. Wearing uniforms designed by Michelangelo and commonly armed with halberds, they are capable of using heavier weapons if needed. Each member is Catholic, male, and Swiss, and *must complete military training in* Switzerland. They must demonstrate good conduct and be at least five-foot eight in height. In extreme circumstances, they are expected to guard the Holy Father with their lives. The Swiss Papal Guard is the oldest active military unit in continual existence since 1506.

*The pope does not live in Italy, he lives in Vatican City, which is a country within Italy.

*Between John Paul II's election to the papacy in 1978 and his death in 2004, more than 17 million people attended his weekly audiences in Rome.
