The Church celebrates three great and familiar saints this month: first. St. Therese of the Child Jesus, October 1st: second. St. Francis of Assisi. 4th of October; and St. Teresa of Avila, 15th of October. What do these saints have in common? They are giants of our faith in terms of their teachings and influence.
