A Message from Father Rick

Inscribed at the eastern entrance of Rockefeller Center in New York Citv are the following words: "Man's ultimate destiny depends not on whether he can learn new lessons or make new discoveries or conquests. but on his acceptance of the lesson taught him close upon two thousand years ago." What is that lesson? It is the lesson of Love. "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind and with all your strength ... and love your neighbor as yourself,: (Mark 12:30-31). Later Jesus would even make these commandments shorter and more powerful, "Love one another, as I have loved you." From now on, the measure of our love either for God or for another is the ultimate love of Jesus for us. By Jesus death on the cross, he made it possible for us to make our sacrifices meaningful and fulfilling. To sacrifice means to make something holy by offering it to God. Jesus continues to offer himself to the Father when we celebrate the Holy Mass, so our participation of the Mass becomes our own sacrifice of loving Jesus and our neighbors. Jesus continues to love us, prays and nourishes us in the celebration of the Mass.
