

This Sunday is called Laetare, a time for rejoicing. Once again, we listen to the familiar story of the prodigal son from the gospel according to St. Luke. The father welcomed the prodigal son and even ordered a big feast for the occasion. Meanwhile, when the dutiful older son knew what was going on, he refused to go in.
