



A Message Land from Father Rick

We begin our commemoration of the Passion of the Lord with the procession and blessings of Palms. We hear that in the Gospel accounts people were shouting Hosanna. Hosanna...as they welcome Jesus to Jerusalem. Hosanna is a joyful Aramaic exclamation of praise which was commonly used to express joy and praise for a victory won or expected. The Gospel to be read or proclaimed this Sunday is the account of the Passion and death of the Lord according to St. Luke. St. Luke presented Jesus as the suffering servant of God who relies on God alone. Jesus accepted death, even death on a cross. When we listen to the account of Jesus judgement and death, let us not become silent spectators, but rather active witnesses of the Gospel. While some of Jesus' friends left and others watched him from a distance, let us take our stand and stay close to Jesus and take responsibility so that we too can stand with the Lord in his Resurrection and glory.
