

A Message from Father Rick

Peter and the other apostles had a long way back home from Jerusalem to Galilee. Many of them including Peter were going back to their former way of life which was fishing. What a wasted three years, so they thought. They could have built one or two more fishing boats. They were filled with regrets and frustrations. Now they had to face the endless blame from the family and the people they left behind. Now they had to start all over again. Peter thought at least he had avoided being incriminated of the crime his master was arrested and sentenced to, death by denying Jesus three times. What a big relief, now they were in Galilee safe and sound after all the drama in Jerusalem. As for the Risen Lord, the mission had just begun. The first calling of the Peter happened in the Sea of Galilee now Jesus would call him again on that same place.
