we celebrate this Sunday is commonly believed to be the birth of the Church. Fifty days after the resurrection of Jesus and one week after His ascension into heaven, the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles. The Jews have the same celebration which they call "Shavuoth." This is a feast they celebrate fifty days after Passover. It is a thanksgiving feast for the first harvest. It also commemorates, back in the Old Testament, the arrival of the Jews at Mt. Sanai after fifty days of journey. The feast of the Pentecost marks the beginning of the Church. Jesus fulfilled His promise to send the Advocate, the Counselor to guide the apostles on the right path so that the gospel would be preached throughout the world. The Holv Spirit did not take away the freedom of the apostles but rather enhanced their capacity to make brave decision and grow as the Church. Today let us continue to pray, that the Holy Spirit will continue to guide the Church and embolden each baptized Christian to decide for Jesus and the Gospel values of Truth, Life, and true Freedom. Today I especially pray that each of you will never give up contributing to the growth of our parish either by your gift of service, generous offerings and pravers.


