



## A Message from Father Rick

*Jesus tells the story of a Pharisee and a tax collector who went into the temple to pray. One praised himself before the Lord and despised the other. The Pharisee had done everything the law had required of him and so he had reasons to brag of his petty achievements before the Lord. His act could have been fine until the moment he turned around and saw someone, not of his kind, and started to belittle and despise the other because the other was considered a public sinner. The tax collector, overwhelmed by guilt and with great remorse and humility, asked for God's Mercy. Jesus reminds us that the temple or the Church is a place where we come and recognize who we are before the Lord and that we are all sinners in need of God's mercy and forgiveness. God wants all his people, His children, to enter into the Kingdom. We cannot be totally content with our faith. One of our biggest challenges is to grow our faith but also to grow our love and respect for others. It is not enough, therefore, to faithfully come to the church and pray, we must also be able to lead others to come and pray with us.*




### \*OCIA beginning soon...
