



A Message from Father Rick

The Jewish people took great pride by them being "the chosen people of God". In order to manifest their conviction of the divine election, they built a magnificent temple for the Lord. King David laid the foundation of the first temple. King David's Altar was the first construction on the site of the temple mount. By about the tenth century before Jesus, King Solomon built a more elaborate temple. This temple would later be destroyed in 586 BCE by the Babylonian invasion. A second temple was built when the Jews returned from the Babylonian captivity. Later, King Herod would make elaborate renovations of the second temple, making it the most beautiful structure standing during the time of Jesus. The temple became the center of Jewish religious activity. In today's gospel Jesus prophesied that even this great temple would not last forever. In deed in 70AD, about 40 years after Jesus' death, the temple would be razed to the ground by the Romans. Material things do not last forever. Everything will come to an end. Jesus warned his disciples not to be concerned about the future impending catastrophic events, but rather to pray for God's intervention of grace and mercy. Jesus reminds us that we do not need to fear those who would oppose us or treat us harshly for following Him. He promises to give us supernatural strength, wisdom, and courage as we make a stand for our faith and witness to the truth and love of Christ.


