



A Message from Father Rick

The Liturgical season of Ordinary time ends with the celebration of Jesus as the King of the Universe. This year we are so blessed to celebrate the 100th since this feast was first instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI for the Roman Catholic Church. Many other Churches including the Anglican, Lutheran, and other Protestant churches also celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. The kingship of Jesus should not be seen as a political title like the kings or emperors that existed long time ago in various parts of the world. The Kingship of Jesus is far greater than any human title we can ever ascribe to Him. Understandably, the title "King of the Universe" means Jesus has absolute dominion over all in the Universe, known and unknown to human, material and spiritual. The Feast also has an "after life" dimension pointing to the end of time when the kingdom of Jesus will be established in all its fullness to the ends of the earth. The Kingship of Jesus goes beyond our concept of matter and time. The Kingdom of the Lord, nonetheless, is a place of peace and joy for those who would be able to come, a paradise. He said to one criminal of his side, "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise. As we Celebrate Thanksgiving this coming Thursday, let us thank the Lord for calling us to be His own people.


***Celebration of the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe**
