





## A Message from Father Rick

Today, together with the whole Church, we celebrate the dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. This Church in Rome is the Cathedral of the pope, which is the official Church where the Holy Father leads the entire Catholic Church throughout the world. Built during the time of Emperor Constantine in 324 AD, it is considered as the oldest Basilica in the Western world. The celebration of the dedication of the Lateran Basilica reminds us of our unity with the church with the Holy Father, Pope Leo as our head and leader. Ultimately, it is Christ's Church. Christ is the head and we are his body. It is not so much of celebrating the dedication of the Church as building made of bricks and stones, but a celebration of dedication of the people of God symbolized by the basilica of Saint John Lateran. No matter how diverse people are around the world, there is always unity in faith. Let us pray that our Celebration today will bring even more unity and peace in the Church and to all Churches throughout the world. It is Christ's Church and as such, we know, the power God will be victorious against the power of evil.

Once again the Altar and Rosary is providing these booklets for the Parish family. They will be available to you beginning next weekend in the back of the church.


### \*OCIA beginning soon...next Sunday!!!
